

Growth vs. Achievement, K-8 and Middle Schools

*Reading/Math Achievement levels (TCAP) versus value-added gains (TVAAS)
in Tennessee schools containing grades 7 and/or 8, 2009-2011*

About this chart

- Each dot represents a K-8 or middle school in MNPS
- Data reflects achievement and gains in reading and math across the school
- Red dots indicate 'high poverty' schools, those with 70% or more of the student body enrolled in the Free/Reduced Lunch program
- The higher a school places on the chart (the Y axis), the greater their value-added gains (TVAAS)
- The further to the right a school places on the chart (the X axis), the greater their achievement scores (TCAP)
